

Lesson Planning Sheet

Scripture Text: 1 Kings 18:1-2, 17-46

Lesson Aims:

What main truth do I want the unsaved child to know (truth about God/Jesus)?: There is only one God, the God of the Bible. He is different from the gods of other religions because he is real.

What do I want the unsaved child to do (wording of salvation thrust)?: Believe in the God of the Bible and trust in Jesus.

What main truth do I want the saved child to know (Main Thrust Statement)?: God keeps his promises.

What do I want the saved child to do (PAS)?: To pray and trust God to keep his promises.

Suggestions for carrying out the PAS: Remind them not to be afraid to tell others about their faith. Warn them to beware of false teachings about God and alert them to beware of teachings about others Gods.

Memory Verse: Isaiah 44:6: "... 'I am the First and I am the Last; Besides Me there is no God.'"

Reinforcements:

Visual Aids: Flannelgraph: figures 1, 2, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16; outdoor background.
When acting out the confrontation, use small stool for altar, stuffed animal for sacrificial lamb.

Ways to involve students: Act out the confrontation scene during the lesson.

Songs to emphasize my Aims: "Missionary Song"; "Nothing is Too Difficult for Thee"

Activity to reinforce my Aims: "Missionary Barrel" craft for saving missionary offerings.
